

How to get Hika Explorer for Android device




This information sheet goes through how to get set up with Hika Explorer on your Android device.

1. Make sure you are Set-up on the Google Play Store

Before you can get Hika Explorer you need to have an account with Google. This is a standard requirement for all Android apps. If you don't have an account, follow the steps in the *appendix* at the end of this document to add an existing Google Account to your device or create a new Google Account to add to your device.

2. Buy Hika Licence

Buy licence from Hika Explorer, *Buy Licence* page. You will receive an email with your Registration Licence login details. <http://hikagroup.com/licence/>






3. Install the App onto your Android device

From your Android device, open the *Google Play Store* and search *Hika Explorer*. Download and install the app.

4. Log in and away you go

Click open *Hika Explorer* App and *Log in* with your *licenced Username* and *Password*.



Appendix



To use Google Play on your Android device, you need a Google Account associated with your device. Additionally, the account must be associated with a Google email address (either Gmail or a Google-hosted domain). Follow these steps to add an existing Google Account to your device or create a new Google Account to add to your device.

Create a Google Play Account for Play Store

- 1) Open the *Play Store* app.
 - If you haven't added an email account to your device, you'll be asked to add a Google Account.
 - If you've already added a Google Account to your device and want to add another, touch Settings > Accounts > Add account > OK.
- 2) Choose whether to add an existing account or create a new one.
- 3) Follow the instructions on the device, which will walk you through signing in to an existing Google Account or creating a new Google Account.
